Short Term/Immediate Costs

- Breeder fees for puppy \$1800-\$2500
- Veterans Service Dogs onsite Training & Handler Training \$6500
- Vet Fees & Initial Supplies \$1000
 - 3 puppy vet visits for exam, initial vaccines including rabies, and fecal exams -\$450
 - Heartworm & flea prevention medication \$200
 - Supplies food, treats, food bowls, bed, leash, collar/harness, toys, etc \$350
- Total \$10,000

Long Term/Annual Costs

- Spay/neuter \$300
- Annual vet visit & immunizations \$500
- Annual grooming fees \$600
